Important Notice regarding Snow Removal along Town Roads

This is a reminder to Greenfield residents who live along town roads. The snowplows not only remove snow from the paved road surface, but from the shoulder generally in the right of way. Markers should be placed no closer than 3 feet from the road. This means that people who place markers at the edge of the road will likely find those markers broken off when the snow melts.

The shoulder is used for snow storage, and must be accessible. The distance the snow is pushed off the road depends on current conditions. If wind is significant issue, it may be pushed further off the road. Heavier snowfalls require more storage space.

If you have markers adjacent to the road, please remove them. Thank you.
